### Requirements

- Reliable and outgoing
- Excellent interpersonal communication skills
- Knowledge of local marine life is beneficial, but not essential
- Positions available for volunteers aged 14+ (individuals under 16 must obtain permission from parent/guardian)

### Commitment

- Minimum of 1 shift per fortnight (shifts last 3 hours)
- Drop-in recruitment day followed by short informal interview:

- Three hour induction and training session to take place from:  
**Saturday 28 March 2015 from 1pm**
